Sun, Smiles, and Summer Skills!

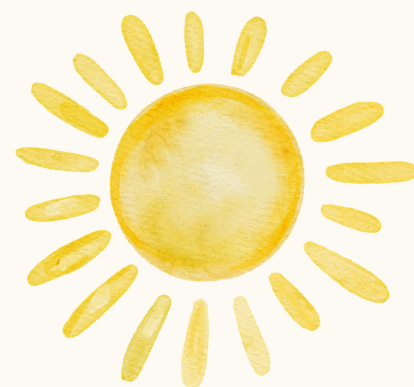
Learning happens everywhere!

Check out these examples!

At the grocery store, practice:

- Public safety skills like staying with caregivers
- Following a shopping list or counting items
- Identifying colors, items, and household necessities
- Waiting in line or patience during shopping
- Requesting preferred foods/snacks



At the pool, practice:

- Following safety directions and caregiver instructions
- Waiting for a turn
- Tolerating sunscreen or floaties
- Asking peers to play or labelling poolside items
